Parking Lot Light Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PG&E is under grounding everything in South Pines. Aiming for January to complete. Have all poles gone by May/June. They won't allow us to have a pole with lights on the parking lot. • One option proposed is solar. Chris in touch with Robin Bennet in Doug Teeter's office who has provided some ideas. Tesla donated panels for the old food bank after the Camp Fire. 	

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<p>Partnership Discussions – PUSD Adventist Health</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • After reviewed the budget and talking about finances - Talking about raising revenue and building partnerships to increase awareness. Chris Rauen, Linda Horton-Lyons, and Donna Yutzy met with Tom Taylor, Superintendent of Schools for PUSD. They are interested in working together to possibly do some programs at our location such as cross-country competitions and programs with the Paradise Highschool Cross Country team, etc. • Chris talking to Jolleen Levy at Adventist Health.

<p>Community Center Update: Rental & Classes, After-school summer program</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not much to report on rentals. Flyer is out (and looks great) and about advertising rentals at the Community Center. • Get 3-4 calls/week...looking for events in the Fall. • Rotary was here last month and had another party last month. • Had a “power meeting” with parents. Really jumped in and came up with lots of ideas for programming. Wonderful ideas from the parents who were here. Will be working with the kids to find out what they want. Ideas on the events include creative lighting, group gathering together with ice breakers, Halloween movie night/day before Trunk or Treat. 6th/7th/8th graders primarily discussed because of who the parents were at the meeting. • Magalia Community Center Youth Council is new name. • Youth Program: Movie & games/crafts - August 9th and 10th 4-6pm. All ages. • Club Night - Junior High kids will be Saturday, August 13. • PTSD Mental Health – Kristy Collins, Chair of Spiritual and Wellness Committee of the Camp Fire Collaborative. Wants to do a 90-minute session. Wants to consider doing it over weekly over 8-9 weeks. She has been trained by a group out of Sonoma “Imagine You” – developed a training with separate modules with very hands-on tools for dealing with trauma. Originally designed for people with secondary trauma: care givers, disaster case managers, etc. to give them tools to help them with their clients. Has been redeveloped for people who have experienced primary trauma directly. A series of modules based on looking at what matters the most...keep coming back to this key component. • Sponsored by Camp Fire Collaborative. Would not cost us anything. • She is ready to go any time after August 12th.

Get a single number that is unique and is the only one and then score is kept and get a rating. • We did have another vandalization – stole the donation box. Need a camera to capture courtyard. Jake knows someone who would be willing to work with us on security. Chris will contact this person to get an assessment of security needs. • Next major event is the Memorial Tournament on October 22. PDGA Masters' Memorial for Terry Sutton. • Jake will be able to get the course cleaned up in the next couple of weeks. • Thinking of doing a St. Jude's fundraiser event.
